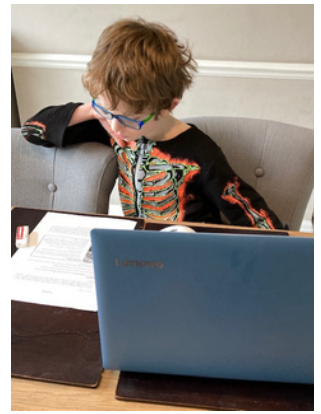

Flexibility

One of our company values is to be flexible. We understand that student's have different needs, backgrounds and challenges. We will take the time to understand the current situation of the student, devise a plan for them and regularly check in to ensure that we pivot necessarily to adapt to their needs.

Quick Turnaround

We deliver results in a time efficient manner whilst personally matching each student. Our team will prioritise according to the student's deadlines that your team provides us. Our average matching time is less than 1 week but we can even be as quick as 1 day.

What type of tutoring do we provide?

Powertutors offers tutoring for students from early years all the way up to mature students, covering almost every subject. We not only are academically driven, but also understand the importance of life skills. We arrange 1-2-1 and group tuition which can be arranged online, face to face at the student's home or in a suitable centre.

Quality Tutors

Our tutors are fully vetted by us. They all must have a QTS or equivalent educational background and SEND experience. All tutors must have an enhanced DBS and at least a safeguarding level 2 certification.

Follow ups

Following our matches, our account leads will follow up with the parent/guardian after the initial lesson to ensure that the student is happy to go ahead. We are also happy to attend PEP or any other meetings where we can be of help at no extra cost.

HOW WE WORK

Our five-step process provides an overview of what happens when you decide to partner with Powertutors to support your pupils. We understand that each student is different and so, this is completely adaptable to the student's specific needs.

1

RECEIVING AND UNDERSTANDING
THE REFERRAL

We will study your referrals and the EHC Plans in order to understand the needs. One of our team members will then be assigned as the lead and they will reply to the referral within 24 hours.

2

GATHERING MORE INFORMATION

In this stage we will gather more information about the student from the parent/guardian or the social worker to understand the current situation and understand the expectations of the tutoring before handpicking the tutor.

3

FINALISING PLANS

In this stage we will send:

- Tutors profile
- Weekly proposed tutoring schedule
- Starting date
- Proposed tutoring plan

TUTORING BEGINS

Once the tutoring begins, we will produce monthly reports where the tutors explain what has been covered, engagement levels of the students and proposed future plans.

5

REVIEW

The lead from Powertutors will monitor the tutoring monthly to ensure everything is going smoothly and according to plan. They will contact the correct individuals who are responsible for the student in case of any change of plans is necessary for the tuition.

STUDENT STORY

"I am a visually impaired student who approached Powertutors after a break down in my college education. As a result, I was granted personal budget with Hampshire County Council for alternative provision under my EHC Plan. My mother and I met with a Powertutors representative, in the summer of 2017, and we discussed my tuition requirements. The rep presented a couple of suitable tutors, allowing me to meet and ask them questions. All the tutors I met were approachable and had numerous qualifications... Powertutors rep and both tutors were very flexible in the allocation of my hours, and the optional units in each subject that I chose to study. They also catered very well for my disability and made me feel as though I was the same as any other student requesting tuition.

After only a couple months of working with the tutors, I underwent an extreme family upheaval. This resulted in me moving approximately 25 miles away to a domestic violence refuge, becoming a looked after child, and taking a six week break in my studies. However, the founder of Powertutors (Nazanin) and the tutors were fantastic. They were able to put my hours on hold until I was ready to resume, and the tutors then travelled the extra distance each day to tutor me in the refuge. They were able to identify that the traditional classroom style of teaching did not always keep me focussed, so they readily accepted the challenge of incorporating other teaching methods. I was given videos, podcasts, and all other available materials to help. The tutors even took me on subject related trips to witness a live lecture, and a live trial in the high courts of London. The tutors managed to find the perfect balance between providing a supportive education, and encouragement of self-study.

Due to the time I was forced to miss (due to COVID -19), both tutors worked through weekends, half term breaks, and even part of the Christmas and easter holidays to enable me to catch up, (they) helped me achieve grades of two As and two A*s.

The tutors were also willing to help me consider my future university options and assisted me in the process of my applications. Even now, after just finishing my second year of a law degree, I am still in touch with Powertutors team. I often still request some assistance from Sue to this day, as her legal knowledge is unbelievable.

I will forever be grateful for the support given to me by the team at Powertutors. *They have enabled me to go on to university, I have never encountered a company with such flexibility, empathy and passion for their jobs as I found with Powertutors."*

VETTING SYSTEM

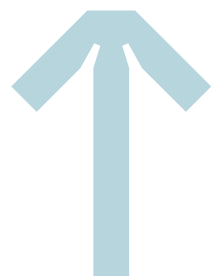
Tutors must undergo a vigorous vetting process carried out by the Powertutors tutor vetting team. They will carry out the following steps before deciding whether we work with the tutor.

2. Virtual interview.
3. Documentation checks
4. Reference checks
5. Decision
